

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MOU") is entered on 27 Day MAY the Year 2000 Indian Trust Act, Year 2023 between: Veterans India organization registered under Indian Trust Act, 1882 basis 1882 having its registered office at D-253, Madhu Vihar Near, Sector-3, Dwarka, New Delhi 11008 its registered office at D-253, Madhu Vihar Near, Sector-7 (Market), Delhi-110059. And Corporate Office Plot-C -713 B, First Floor, Sector-7 (Market), Dwarka, New Delhi110077.1ndia, of the FIRST PARTY;

AND

(SANKETIKA VIDYA PARISAHD ENGINEERING COLLEGE, P.M.PALEM, VISAKHAPATNAM)

WHEREAS Veterans India is a National apolitical patriotic non-profitable organization of Veterans from all fields led by an Ex-Servicemen (which includes Gallantry Awardees, Martyr's families, Disabled Soldiers, Ex-Servicemen and their families) to inculcate patriotism, nationalism and integrity among citizens of the Nation especially youth and students.

AND WHEREAS the parties, through professional interactions and collaboration seek to bring patriotism, nationalism and integrity in students of higher education Institutions (HEIs) of India by merging veterans experience and guidance through higher education activities, both enter into this agreement to establish a strategic partnership in the areas given in more details in the succeeding paragraphs.

Preamble and Objectives

The objective of this MOU defines standards for the overall development of UG and PG students by bringing a Military touch that enables the youth to grow in all three dimensions (Mansa, Vacha and Karmana). ٩.

Strategic Collaboration (Objectives, Scope & Outcome)

The Veterans India and (Name of College) under this MOU, shall collaborate towards:

- 1. Bringing nationalism and patriotism in higher education Institutions (HEIs)/Universities through activities based on veterans India themes and sharing experiences of Ex-Servicemen.
- 2. Personality development and Strategy building practices within higher education Institutions / Universities by involving local Veterans within higher education Institutions/ University vicinity.







- Targeted preparation for SSB/CDS and other military examinations and interviews.
- Modernizing NCC culture in higher education Institutions/ University vicinity by quick adoption model.
- 5. Connecting youth with veterans to make 2nd innings of veterans a better place full of knowledge and joy.
- 6. Adoption of Must Train method [Strategy and Tactics] for self-defense and national security.
- Working together for the welfare of Gallantry Awardees, Martyr's families, Disabled Soldiers, Ex-Servicemen and their families.
- 8. Weekly/Monthly Activities to bring veterans from India and retired Military personnel into Induction level programs in higher education Institutions/Universities.
- Monetary Compensation to Veterans for sessions they attend as speakers or expert to share their experience post-retirement.
- 10. All Sports/ physical fitness activities are to be conducted in collaboration with the Veterans India Youth Wing to meet the objective of the FIT India movement launched by the Honourable Prime Minister.
- 11. The college / Institute/ University shall provide premises in their campus free of cost and available manpower to Veterans India for patriotic activities as and when required besides above mention activities.
- 12. Facilitation of appropriate internship opportunities to the students in all applicable aspects of the organization including management and technology sectors in their Wings.

Definitive Agreement

Any cost associated with the execution of the objectives of this MOU, if any, shall be mutually discussed and agreed to between the parties in a definitive agreement, before carrying out the activity.







Tenure and Termination

This MOU is valid for five (5) years initially and will be deemed renewed for three years unless terminated otherwise.

١.

This MOU shall commence as set forth above and remain in effect through the end of the term unless:

- Otherwise superseded by another agreement between the parties.
- b. The parties mutually agree to terminate this MOU.
- c. Either party gives the other 90 days' written notice of their intent to terminate this MOU.
- d. A breaching party has failed to cure a material breach of this MOU within 30 days following written notice of that breach given by the non-breaching party.

Each party is an independent contractor and no provision of this MOU grants either party any express or implied right or authority to assume or create any obligations or responsibility on behalf of or in the name of the other party or bind the other party in any manner or thing whatsoever.

Neither party shall assign or transfer the privileges and obligations under this MOU without the prior written consent of the other party.

The law of the Republic of India shall govern this MOU. Any dispute between the

parties arising in connection with the performance of this MOU shall be resolved amicably between the parties through a process of negotiation before the use of any judicial remedy before the appropriate forum. Both parties irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts at New Delhi, for any action or proceeding.

Any changes to the MOU are to be mutually agreed to by Veterans India and the (Name of College/Institute/University) and executed in writing.

Anil, Principal, hereinafter referred to as "Party of the SECOND Part" or "SAVE" which expression wherever it occurs, shall mean and include the representatives, administrators, successors in interest and assign.

Both parties hereinafter shall collectively refer to as "Parties"

1. WHEREAS:

The Party of the FIRST PART, MTS, is currently upskilling learners and aims to provide systematic solutions for all concerns in the field of Engineering and Business Management. We offer training in Software, Hardware, Electronics and conduct Seminars, Workshops, Career Guidance. In addition to that, Macrodots has come up with placement assured programs in Engineering, Technology and Businesses.

The Party of the SECOND PART Sanketika Vidya Parishad Engineering College (SAVE), Beside Y.S.R. International Cricket Stadium, P.M.Palem, Visakhapatnam - 530041 is an Engineering college with 20 years of Academic Excellence, Affiliated to Andhra University, Visakhapatnam and Approved by AICTE, New Delhi. It was established in the year 2003 under Sri Srinivasara Vidya Parishad Trust.

The Parties hereby express their willingness to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding to set out the framework to carry-out training of learners as per job roles(s) related to Information Technology.

2. PREAMBLE

- 2.1 MTS, want to be part of any organizational digital transformation in their adoption towards Automation, Cloud ecosystem, Artificial intelligence (AI), Business intelligence (BI) and other situation calls for adapting as needed.
- 2.2 SAVE has evolved as one of the top institutions in Andhra Pradesh, and is an Industry Connected Institution. To impart industry relevant skills, SAVE has collaborated with various industries and set up Centers of Excellence (CoE) to carry out training and to give a real-time hands-on experience. The Institute focuses on holistic development of



students by adopting the most innovative and creative dimension to impart quality education and employability skills.

- 2.3 MTS & SAVE believes that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- 2.4 The Parties intended to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education.
- 2.5 The Parties hereby express their willingness to combine their resources for skill development in technology and related sectors, and work towards promoting the growth of the sector by creating necessary eco-system for the said purpose.

3. SCOPE OF MoU

The Parties have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding to express their interest on collaborating on joint activities that will described in various project agreements entered into by the parties:

4.1 ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MTS

- 1. MTS shall undertake to collaborate with SAVE on mutually agreed activities pursuant to IT TRAINING and Job Interview Assistance.
- 2. MTS shall provide in demand courses for the SAVE students.
- 3. MTS shall facilitate Mock interviews to the students.
- 4. MTS will facilitate internship support for the students who have completed the required training modules of the MTS programs.
- 5. MTS will extend support for delivering the courses
- 6. MTS will extend support for developing job oriented curriculum and cloud development inputs.
- 7. MTS shall appoint a 'Point of Contact' for necessary coordination with SAVE.

4.2 ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF SAVE

- SAVE shall undertake to collaborate with MTS on mutually agreed activities pursuant I. to project agreements entered into by the parties.
- II. SAVE shall facilitate interested student engagement in the MTS training programs.
- III. SAVE shall provide the space and facility to conduct the training-related activities in their premises.
- SAVE shall facilitate the credit transfer option for the MTS training programs. IV.
- SAVE shall provide support for developing a Center of Excellence at University V. premises.
- SAVE shall appoint a 'Point of Contact' for necessary coordination with MTS. VI.

4.3 JOINT ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MTS AND SAVE

- 1. The Parties would provide support as mutually agreed upon in training agreements.
- 2. The Parties would undertake and execute the mutually agreed tasks within a stipulated time frame.
- 3. The Parties would provide Job ready Skill and Support to the learners.
- 4. The parties would execute joint collaboration activities for training, mock interviews and preparation to IT Job related activities
- 5. The parties will develop courses/programs at the UG/PG level with Specialisation IT and Business Technology

6. The Parties may also enter into a separate arrangement/agreement on a case-to-case basis, on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed by the parties.

5 DURATION OF Moll

The total time frame of the engagement would be for a period of 3 (three) years from the date of signing this MoU. The term of this MoU may be extended as may be mutually decided by the Parties.

DELIVERABLES 6

The deliverables would be as detailed in the scope of each task, mutually agreed between the parties, from time to time. Requisitions for a specific task could be given by any of the parties on mutually agreed terms of references that would be specific to identified projects.

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT

This will be undertaken by separate financial terms & conditions on a learner basis on mutually agreed terms by the parties. Each Party shall bear its expenses in discharge of its responsibilities mentioned in this MoU.

CONFIDENTIALITY AND NON-DISCLOSURE

Except as otherwise contemplated by this MoU, each Party (the "receiving party") undertakes that, in order to protect the proprietary interest of the other Party (the "disclosing party") in the disclosing Party's confidential information, it will not, during the term of this MoU nor at any time thereafter, either use or exploit in any manner, or directly or indirectly divulge or disclose to others any of the disclosing party's confidential information. The receiving party shall treat all confidential information disclosed to it as strictly confidential and only use such confidential information for the purposes of this MoU. Each Party shall ensure that its directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives, students, faculty, Affiliates and attorneys comply at all times with this confidentiality undertaking. This clause does not apply to (i) information that is public other than because of a breach of this clause; (ii) disclosure required by law; or (iii) disclosure to a Party's related companies, auditor, banker or advisors. Specific confidentiality and non-disclosure agreement will be a part of specific MoUs agreed by the Parties for each project.

VII. AMENDMENTS TO MoU

In the event that any of the representations or warranties made/given by a party ceases to be true or stands changed, the party who had made such representation or given such warranty shall promptly notify the others of the same.

VIII. **TERMINATION OF MoU**

This MoU may be terminated by either of the parties forthwith if the any party commits a. breach of any of the terms hereof and shall have failed to rectify such breach within sixty open days of the notice in this behalf having been served on it by the other parties.



In addition to the reasons for termination as set forth above, this MoU may be terminated b. forthwith by any of the parties voluntarily by giving sixty (60) days' notice in writing to other parties OR involuntarily due to entering into composition, bankruptcy or similar reorganization proceedings or if applications invoking such proceedings have been filed and with the advance notice of 3 months by any of the parties.

IX. NOTICES

a. Method of Notice. The parties shall give all notices and communications between the parties in writing by (i) personal delivery, or (ii) a nationally-recognized, next-day courier service, or (iii) registered postal services, or (iv) or (v) electronic mail to the party's address specified in this agreement, or to the address that a party has notified to be that party's address for the purposes of this section addressing to the address me


